First Qualified PRE Breeding Stallion for New Zealand

June 2007

We are proud to announce the arrival of the first Qualified PRE Breeding Stallion to New Zealand, scheduled for mid July.

This is the fulfillment of a dream, almost 8 years in the making, since we were offered the first stallion from Spain, at a time where we were not in the position to attempt such a project. Ever since, during each subsequent visit to Spain, we have been looking quietly, to see what type of stallion would suit our situation best.

Not until Sabina's last visit, in November 2006, did the right animal come along, in the form of "Jaleador". We had visited the stud farm of Jacobo Corsini before and were very impressed with the animals he has. In fact all of them, youngsters, broodmares and stallions are of the classic type that we value so much. So when the opportunity presented itself in November 2006, we started to plan for such an ambitious project seriously.

It is no mean feat trying to get an animal from Spain to New Zealand, which is about the furthest you can send an animal and into a country with one of the strictest importation regulations of all. But finally, the project is set to succeed, with the arrival of "Jaleador" scheduled for mid July.

At this stage, the horse is still in quarantine in Europe and doing very well—we are getting regular updates about his wellbeing from the quarantine station.

This will be the first ever breeding stallion that has come to NZ directly from Spain, and the first qualified breeding stallion in NZ and Australia.

All going well, we hope to make him available for service by AI only (fresh/

chilled & frozen, depending on circumstances) for the coming breeding season which starts in September/October. "Jaleador" will be transported to a specialist reproduction centre for a set number of weeks each season, and all semen will be collected, stored and dispatched from there.

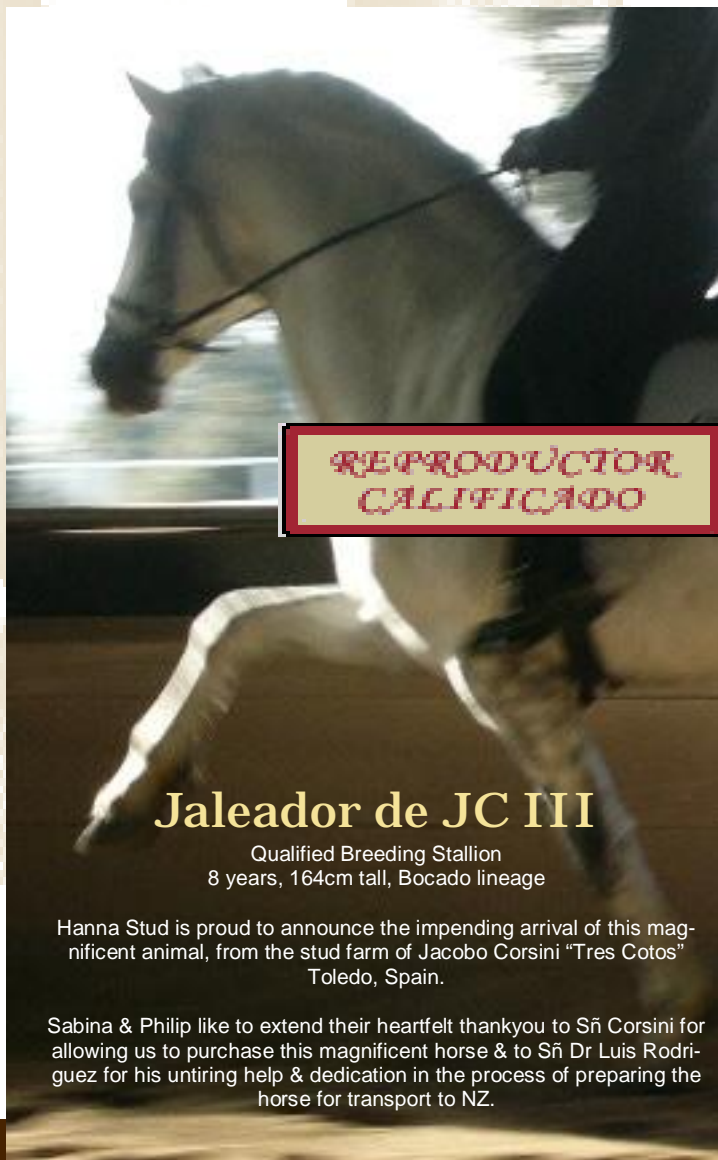
